

Mahrt's Mist Net Bag

Materials:

- T-shirts (adult sizes work best)
- Sewing machine
- Serger (optional)
- Pattern at the end of the document

Directions:

- Print pattern, cut out and tape pieces together.
- Fold t-shirt in half long ways. Line the pattern up on the fold, trace it or pin it to the shirt, and cut it out.
- Face right sides in and stitch across the top of the handles (Fig 1).
 - I serged first then stitched across with the sewing machine.
- Open the bag and lie flat (with wrong side up). Allow the edges to roll.
 - You can iron a hem or free hand the roll, be sure to tuck the raw edges under.
 - Stitich around the circle and the outside edges of the handles (Fig 2).
- Line up the sides of your bag (with wrong sides together). Sew the sides and bottom (you can serge or not). Do not sew the cut outs in the corners yet (Fig 3).
- Now bring the 2 corners at bottom edge together to make a box corner and stitich (Fig 4).
- Now you have a bag for your mist net.

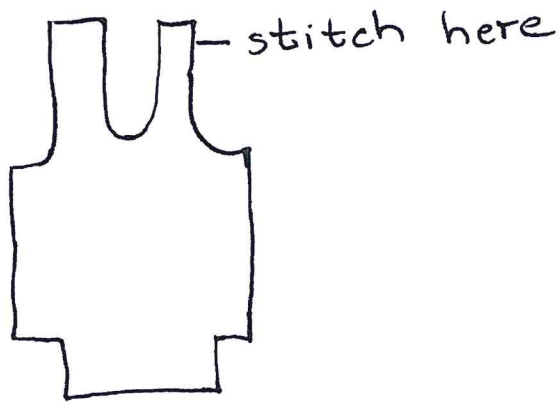

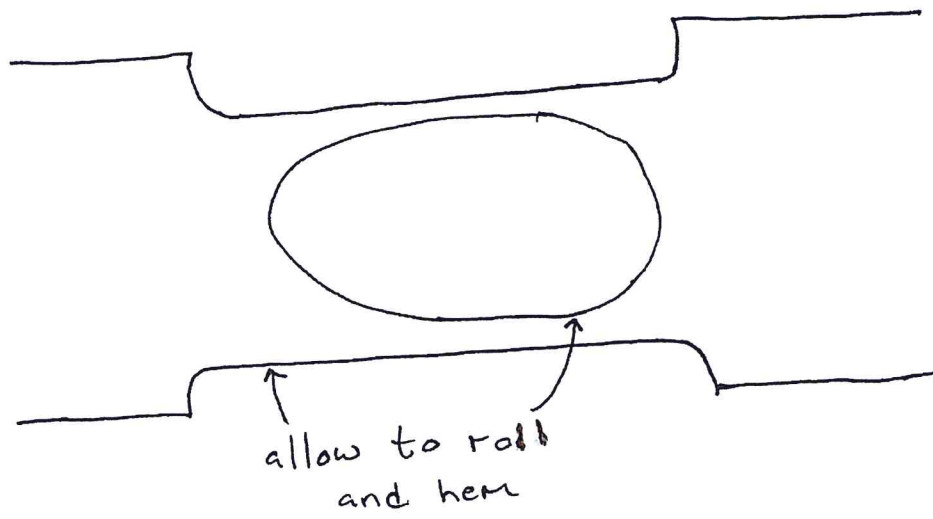

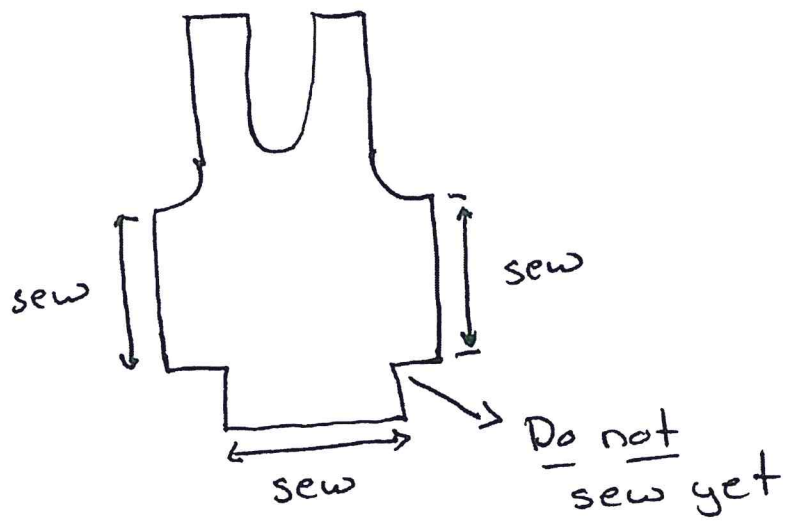

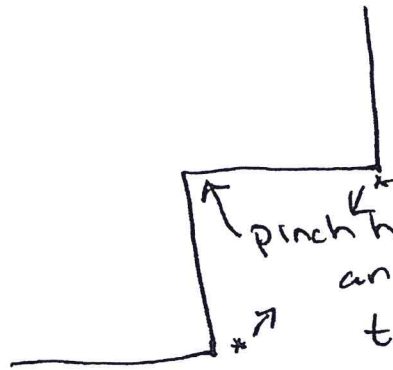
